

## VIRTUAL SCHOOL POLICY

### LATE ENROLLMENT

Students applying for admission to the Massachusetts Virtual Academy at Greenfield after October 1<sup>st</sup> in any year will be considered “late-enrolling” students. Applications will be considered under this late enrollment policy.

Applications for late-enrolling students will be considered viable for the year of application if there is a reasonable expectation that the student:

- 1) can complete a year-long program before the beginning of the next school year, and
- 2) can be reasonably well-prepared for year-end state testing.

Review of late enrollment applications will consider:

- cause of a late application,
- prior school attendance for current year and requirements,
- course work accomplishment for the current year and requirements,
- complexity of student program for student’s grade level,
- motivation of student and past academic achievement.

Following a review of a late enrollment request, parents will be notified of the school’s acceptance, recommendation to begin the virtual academy the following year, or other recommendation.
