Please note that home delivery is still an option with these waivers. Families can get home delivery for anyone 18 and under in the home during this time. Meals will be left on the porch and a team member will wait at the curb to make sure it is brought in for food safety reasons. Please make sure that someone retrieves the meal package and that meal items are stored or heated according to directions. If the meal does not get taken in within 5 minutes, we cannot leave it at the door. Contact elical1@gpsk12.org to request home delivery.

Parent pick-up is still allowed at this time.

In-person learners will receive meals daily.
