THE PEOPLE AND THEIR SCHOOL DISTRICT

The Committee recognizes that ultimate responsibility for public education rests with the people as vested in the state, but individual School Committees have been assigned specific authority through state law. In carrying out its statutory duties, the Greenfield School Committee declares its intent to:

- 1. Maintain two-way communication with the community, keeping the public informed of the progress and problems of the school system through an established protocol for School Committee public relations.
- 2. To conduct its business in compliance with Massachusetts Municipal Government Open Meeting Law (M.G.L. Ch. 39, Section 23B) and to stay accessible to the public we represent.
