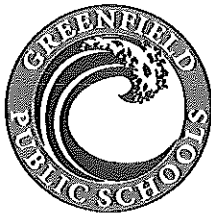

Please find the following summary of the FY18 Projected Revolving Account Revenues and Expenditures to be used against the Districts all funds budget projection. These active accounts are measured constantly over the fiscal year to ensure our ability to offset their funding.

The following revolving accounts are maintained with a \$2,500 average annual value or less. These funds are intended to be fiscal year offsets, but are managed under a cash-in / cash-out basis as expenditures are charges against the accounts:

- After School Program Fund,
- School Damages Book Fund,
- Summer School Funds,
- Adult Education, and
- School Sales Fund.

The following revolving accounts are being held from use due to eliminating their program activities:

- Federal After School Program
- Four Corners After School Program
